The County of Dorset (Various Roads, Bourton) (30mph Speed Limit) (No.3) Order 2024

Dorset Council in exercise of powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of the Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, hereby make the following Order: -

- No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 1.
- ² 'The Trunk Roads (40mph Speed Limit) (No 2) Order 1983' is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the lengths of road specified in schedule 1 to the order.
- This Order may be cited as The County of Dorset (Various Roads, Bourton) (30mph Speed Limit) (No.3) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on the 21st June 2024.

(C173)New Road, Bourton	From a point 173 metres North East of its junction with Tan Lane, in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 2.02 kilometres.
High Street, Bourton	From its junction with (C173)New Road, in a northern direction for 98 metres.
Tan Lane, Bourton	From its junction with (C173)New Road, for its entire length.
Olde Fairfield, Bourton	For its entire length.
Silton Road, Bourton	For its entire length.
Mill Lane, Bourton	For its entire length.
Brickyard Lane, Bourton	For its entire length.
West Bourton Road, Bourton	From its junction with (C173)New Road, in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 395 metres.
Church Track, Bourton	For its entire length.
Woolcott Lane, Bourton	From its junction with (C173)New Road, in a northernly direction, for a distance of 82 metres.
Chaffeymoor Hill, Bourton	From its junction with (C173)New Road, in a northernly direction, for a distance of 233 metres.
