a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

We will continue to offer our services in a responsible and appropriate manner. Our Managing Directors and Management Teams have procedures in place to deal with every kind of situation, we have many years of extensive experience in dealing with the public due to owning several established holiday Parks and shops. Our staff are well trained and vigilant.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Vigilant staff will ensure that ID is requested if someone attempting to purchase alcohol (or any other age - restricted items) appears to be under the age of 25. If valid ID cannot be produced then alcohol will not be sold to that person, nor any other age - restricted items. CCTV inside and outside the shop will help to deter anyone with criminal intent. We will report any incident of a criminal or disorderly nature to the relevant authorities.

c) Public safety

Public safety is always at the forefront of our aims. Our Managing Directors and our Management Teams have procedures in place to deal with every type of incident and will not hesitate to report any public safety occurrences to the relevant authorities.

We have many years of extensive experience in dealing with the public and in protecting public safety.

One example: In addition to CCTV, we have installed the correct lighting inside and outside the building to help ensure public safety.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The prevention of public nuisance is also at the forefront of our aims at all times. Our Managing Directors and our Management Teams have procedures in place to deal with every type of incident, our staff are well trained and we will not hesitate to report any occurrences to the relevant authorities.

We have many years of extensive experience in dealing with the public and in preventing public nuisance.

e) The protection of children from harm

Vigilant staff will ensure that ID is requested if someone attempting to purchase alcohol (or any other age restricted purchases) appears to be under the age of 25. If valid ID cannot be produced, then alcohol or other age-restricted items will not be sold to that person. All appropriate steps will be taken to protect children from harm. Any incidents will be reported to the relevant authorities.
