Margins and clear space

The ideal clear space margin around the logo is 15% of the height of the logo. For example if the logo was sized at 100px, the margin of clear space would be 15px.

Minimum size

The minimum size for legible display of the logo is 100px in height for digital applications and 15mm in height in print.

Contrast and legibility

The logo must be placed on a sufficiently contrasting background. If the primary coloured logos aren't legible enough switch to either the dark grey block or the white block version.

Dark grey block logo - To be used on lighter backgrounds



Mono logo - To be used on mono artwork



White block logo - To be used on darker backgrounds

Logo - Do's and don'ts

Don't crop the logo



Don't squish or tilt the logo



This doesn't reflect the logo correctly, use either dark grey or white block logo as they are



Don't alter any colours




No additional borders

Give the logo clear space


