

**THE DORSET COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME, VARIOUS ROADS,  
DORCHESTER (ORDER 202\*)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of Dorset proposes to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

Order one will be to introduce the following restrictions:

- Introduce 'no waiting Monday to Friday 8am-9am and 3pm-4pm' restrictions along a section of Mellstock Avenue and Rothesay Road, Dorchester (refer to plan for extent).
- Introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions at the junction of Mellstock Avenue and Rothesay Road.

Order two will be to introduce the following:

Introduce 'prohibition of motor vehicles' on a section of Barnes Way, Dorchester during the hours of 8.20am until 9.00am and 2.55pm until 3.35pm on every school day.

Relevant exemptions will apply where appropriate and as necessary in accordance with the provisions of the Order.
